

## **PRESSURE-FLOW CURVE**








- Hold the mask steadily on your face and pull the headgear over your head.
  Bringing the lower straps below your ears, clip the headgear to the lower part of the frame.
  Undo the fastening tabs on the upper headgear straps. Pull the straps evenly towards the top of head or above ears until the mask is stable and comfortable. Reattach the fastening tabs.

- 6. Your mask and headgear should be positioned as shown in the illustration.

! Note

Connect the device air tubing to the swivel of mask and ensure it is firmly connected.
